
Reapply sunscreen every two hours to stay protected!

## Year Group News

### Nursery

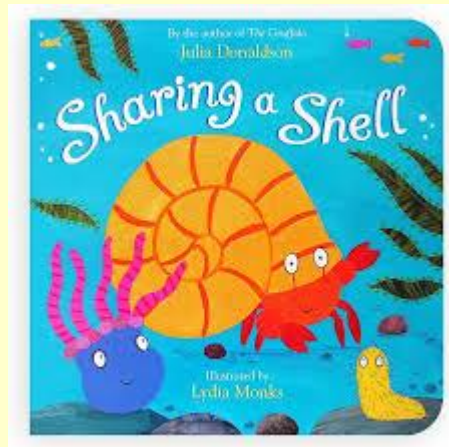


'We have started our new topic, 'Summer Time'. We read the story 'Lucy and Tom at the Seaside', and the children have talked about their own trips to the seaside. We are all getting excited for Seaside Day on **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup>**. Please see the letter that was sent home for details of what your child will need. If you need another copy, please ask a member of staff.




Next week we will be starting our new 'Talk for Writing' story, 'Sharing a Shell'. Look out for a copy of the story and the story map coming home this week. The children will be learning our simple version of the story and retelling it using the story map. We will also be creating lots of sea creatures.

In Phonics sessions we are learning two new sounds each week. Ask your child which sounds they have learnt and how to 'Fred Talk'.



### Reception



This week the children have used their imaginations to change parts of the story for 'The snail and the whale'. We changed the whale to a  different sea creature and the icebergs they saw on their journey to something else i.e. Rocks or caves. The children then created their own story map by drawing pictures to innovate it. In maths the children have really enjoyed our continued work on 'sharing' and 'grouping'. We have also been brushing up on our 'doubles' as well.

Next week the children will be writing their 'innovated' version of their story in Talk for Writing, in maths they will be investigating patterns, positions and instructions. On Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> June we will be having our 'seaside day' where we are looking forward to sand, paddling pools, ice lollies and pony rides.



**Lovely Ladybirds** – you will be having your 'beach fun' in the morning. You need to come to school with your swimming costume already underneath your beach clothes ie. Shorts and t shirt. Please bring a bag with the following in – a towel, a set of dry clothes (including pants) a bucket and spade (named). Please apply sun cream before school, but children can apply it themselves at school throughout the day. Please see letter we handed out last week for further details and payment details.

**Brilliant Butterflies** – you will be having your 'beach fun' in the afternoon. Therefore please **don't** wear your swimming costume to school. We will get changed after lunchtime. Please bring a bag with the following in – your swimming costume, a set of dry clothes (including pants) a bucket and spade (named). Please apply sun cream before school, but children can apply it themselves at school throughout the day. Please see letter we handed out last week for further details and payment. You can wear 'beach clothes' all day and you don't need to bring your reading folder. Please remember water bottles though.

### Key Stage One



This week, the children have been learning all about the Olympics and how to keep their bodies healthy. They've enjoyed discussing the importance of exercise, a balanced diet and being hygienic.



Looking ahead to next week, we have a lot of exciting learning planned. In English, the children will be focusing on grammar, including how to use speech marks correctly and exploring a range of words to use instead of "said" to make their writing more interesting.

In Maths, Year 1 will be working with numbers from 1 to 100, developing their number recognition and counting skills. Meanwhile, Year 2 will dive into statistics, learning how to collect, sort, and interpret data.

In Art, we'll be exploring different types of printing, using a variety of materials to create unique and colourful pieces. We'll also begin a special class project to design and create a sports flag for Sports Day. This will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to work together in groups, design collaboratively and experiment with joining fabric.

It's shaping up to be another creative and energetic week of learning!
