Comparison of William Lilley and National Data

Analysis of the responses found the following percentages of people strongly agreed and agreed.

We compare our data against National data from the Ofsted Parent View responses to highlight where we are in-line with National responses, above or below. We use this information to focus on improvements to be made.

The information below represents a comparison of the results of the National Ofsted parent view data and our own. Please note that the national comparative data has been taken from 2025 due to a change in the Ofsted data gathering

WHAT WE DO WELL

Based on this data, at William Lilley's parent responses are more positive or in line with average responses reported by the national survey comparisons, with considerably higher than national responses within the following responses;

- My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed
- This school has high expectations for my child
- My child does well at this school
- The school lets me know how my child is doing
- There is a good range of subjects available for my child at this school
- The school supports my child's wider personal development
- I would recommend this school to another parent

This year, there has not been a consensus in regards to improvements that can be made. However, reference was made to the changes brought about by established team members moving onto new opportunities. As new staff have settled into their roles and teams have become established over the year, we have seen increasing stability and continuity across the school, and we are pleased with the positive impact these changes are now having on pupils' and experiences and outcomes and relationships with parents.

We have also recruited further permanent experienced members of staff to the team who will be joining our school family in September. We know that this will provide an opportunity to strengthen our team and bring fresh perspectives and expertise to our provision which will bring long-term benefits to our school community.

Throughout any change our nurturing and caring ethos remains at the heart of our school. This year we have updated our vision to celebrate our strengths and successes in ensuring every child is known, celebrated and thriving. We are pleased with the positive responses within our survey and are particularly delighted that 100% of parents agree that their child is doing well at our school, reflecting the positive experiences and progress of our pupils.
